"Safety Leadership Foundations" is designed to help you as a Supervisor or Manager to manage your safety tasks within the Safety Competency framework researched by the CRC. Specifically:

- Learn how to manage challenging safety conversations with others
- Improve your ability to motivate others to be safe in the workplace, all day and every day
- Share ideas and learn from others in your industry
- Strengthen your own leadership skills

If you hold a safety critical role, knowledge or understanding is not enough. This program helps you build the skills and competencies to manage the safety of others in your workplace more effectively.

Program Outcomes for Participants include:

- Reflect on your current workplace and review and raise safety issues and ideas
- Review your understanding of legal obligations through access to a specialist lawyer
- Review and practice communication skills for Toolbox, pre-start meetings and 1:1 safety discussions
- Understand how to manage risk effectively in your workplace
- Identify key features of a safe and high performing work culture
- Determine practical and tangible methods for developing others to behave safely
- Discover how to manage people who demonstrate unsafe behaviours
- Learn how to improve safety reporting (incidents and near misses)
- Uncover how to get people at all levels to change their approach and think about safety
- Determine why people behave unsafely and how to resolve the problem
- Discover more about your leadership style. What is effective? What can be added?
- Identify what 'great safety' looks like and develop strategies to move towards it
- Gain insights into what successful companies have done in the area of Safety Leadership and what current safety research tells us is important and effective
